1. AEN 105 (Communication Skills) will be offered this semester (September–December 2026) while PHT 112 (HIV/AIDS Determinants, Prevention, and Management) will be offered in January–April 2027,.
2. Students may only register for modules they have paid for, in line with university policy. The minimum module load is 4 for undergraduates and 3 for postgraduates. Students should register only for modules they plan to take exams in.
3. All academic activities, including exam moderation and results release, will follow the approved Maseno University trimester dates.
4. Any enquiries related to learning content or examination results should be directed to the Dean of the School or the School eCampus Programme Coordinator (ePC).
5. eCampus programmes run for 10 weeks with 6 hours of learning per module per week, in line with university requirements.
6. Heads of Department, through Deans, are expected to float courses for registration on the MIS during the first week of each semester to enable early course selection and payment. eLearning students can only select the number of modules they have paid for.
7. The Mid-Semester Week is reserved for schools to organize virtual or blended engagement sessions with students. Specific dates should be communicated by the ePC.
8. A semester opening meeting will be held at the start of each semester for eCampus staff, Deans, HODs, and teaching staff involved in that semester's delivery.
